

NZAS Retirement Fund Balanced option

Fund update for the year ended 30 June 2024

This fund update was first made publicly available on 19 September 2024.

What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Balanced option (**fund**) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. NZAS Retirement Fund Trustee Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.


Description of this fund

The fund has a higher allocation to growth assets (equities, listed property and listed infrastructure) than to income assets (fixed interest and cash and cash equivalents). The investment objective of the fund is to achieve average returns of 1.5% per annum above Consumers Price Index increases over rolling eight-year periods at least 65% of the time.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Balanced option



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the Fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

How has the fund performed?


Example of how this applies to an investor


Mary had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Mary received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$475 (that is 4.75% of her initial \$10,000). Mary did not pay any other charges (aside from insurance charges). This gives Mary a total return after tax of \$475 for the year, less insurance charges.

International Listed Infrastructure: 100% hedged to the NZ dollar.

International Fixed Interest: 100% hedged to the NZ dollar.
